

GHIDINI LIGHTS UP THE MALATESTA CASTLE IN CORIANO



Brescia, 28 September 2007– With the assistance of the Technical Lighting Design Office and using the Spiona, Daytona and Neo models, Ghidini Illuminazione light up the Coriano Malatesta Castle (RM), Italy: a fascinating complex dating to the first half of the 400s, attributed to the Malatesta, which overlooks Coriano from the highest hill in the area. Ghidini's Lighting Design Dept. carefully weighed the fundamental requirements of the project in its planning, the most important of which was deciding the layout of the lighting fixtures so that they would not be visible or actually completely hidden from view in order to prevent any interference with the architecture. A second need, among others, was to obtain the right balance of light color temperature which was suitable to the environment and the complex absorption level of the devices that was contained enough to limit the operating costs.

After taking into consideration and dealt with these criteria during the consultation phase and providing the products, allowed the designer to hide the lighting source to further enhance the architecture, the material value being the ability to intervene with side lighting. This public and architectural lighting project that Ghidini Illuminazione performed, was conducted by following the method and the use of lighting sources with different temperatures and color output to then create "sodium halide" blends, using adequate doses of the contributions provided by each type of light source.

The result is an optimum visual that allowed them to enhance the history, the details and the beauty of Malatesta Castle of Coriano, such as the vaulted main doorway where a backlighting effect was created to create depth, or the Tower for which high output spot lights were used, equipped with optical control accessories which allowed the designers to light up and define the points of the structure in order to obtain a “beam of light” which elongates in an upward direction.
